

CONFLICT MINERALS

Stena Aluminium AB's suppliers are expected to take reasonable measures to ensure that parts and products that are delivered to Stena Aluminium AB are "Congo conflict free", i.e. no conflict minerals benefiting armed groups in the Democratic Republic of Congo. Conflict free means that no such parts or deliveries comprise metals originating from "conflict minerals", which are defined as:

- (i) coltan (tantalum)
- (ii) cassiterite (tin)
- (iii) gold
- (iv) wolframite (tungsten)
- (v) all derivatives from the above

The aim of this policy is to ensure that Stena Aluminium AB's products do not, either directly or indirectly, finance or benefit armed groups by means of mining operations or the trade in minerals in the Democratic republic of Congo or a neighboring country. Stena Aluminium AB expects its suppliers to formulate policies, long-term guidance and management systems in accordance with the guidelines OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas, which have been formulated to meet this goal, to the extent they deem suitable for the individual business.

Stena Aluminium AB does not buy any materials, as raw material or any other type of input goods, classified as conflict mineral. For the metals specifically pointed out above, these are elements that are not expected, in any way, to be a part of Stena Aluminium AB's products, rather, from our perspective, they are considered as unwanted. Therefore, the problem as such is not relevant for Stena Aluminium AB.
